Enrolment for Electoral Roll

Non-resident property owners are urged to complete the necessary enrolment form to be entitled to vote in a ward in which they do not reside, for the October 2009 Municipal Election.

All residents who are enrolled on the State Electoral Roll are automatically entitled to vote in the Ward in which they reside. Property owners who own property in another ward or are absent owners are required to register on the Shire Electoral Roll to receive a vote.

Enrolments close on 28th August although they can be submitted at any time.

Enrolment forms are available from the Shire Office and anyone who is in anyway unsure of their status on the Shire of Cuballing Electoral Roll is encouraged to contact the Shire Office.
