**Are you applying for a building licence on behalf of a builder?** If someone has recommended that you get an owner-builder licence but they take care of and organise all the work, you are putting yourself at significant risk.

#### THE RISKS

As an owner-builder **YOU** are:

- Legally responsible for the management and supervision of the entire project from start to finish, and for 6 years after.
- Liable if the building work does not comply with all building standards and safety regulations.

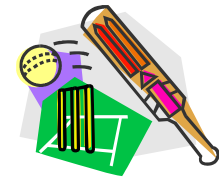
Always ensure you have adequate water nearby and more than one personnel on site when burning and if possible notify neighbours, property owners/occupiers.
