

## **REGIONAL STRATEGIC WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN**

### **PUBLIC COMMENT NEEDED**

The Shires of Cuballing, Dumbleyung, Lake Grace, Narrogin, Pingelly, Wagin, Wandering, West Arthur, Wickopin, Williams, Woodanilling and the Town of Narrogin combined resources to prepare a Draft Regional Strategic Waste Management Plan.

The Regional Strategic Waste Management Plan has been developed in alignment with the Waste Management Board of Western Australia's Zero Waste Plan Development Scheme. The purpose of this Plan is to provide strategies and actions to guide the Local Governments and communities of the region to improve waste management practices consistent with the State's vision of *Towards Zero Waste* which has a 2020 deadline.

After consideration by each of the 12 Councils it is now necessary to place the plan on public exhibition for thirty days for comment and feedback. Copies of the Plan can be obtained from your local council or can be downloaded from the websites of any of the participating councils.

Closing date for the submission of comments is Friday 14<sup>th</sup> of November. Comments, preferably in electronic form, should be addressed to the CEO of your local council and clearly marked "Regional Strategic Waste Management Plan".
