## Background

The Department of Environment and Conservation (DEC) has received an application from Peter and Alison Lacey to place a restrictive covenant on Lot 7 Springhill Road, Cuballing.

Council registered a restrictive covenant (K123439) in March 2007, to protect the native vegetation on the land as a condition of a previous subdivision approval.

DEC has advised that there would be no conflict between the two documents. however the proposed restrictive covenant would provide equivalent protection for the vegetation, together with ongoing management advice and assistance which will be available through their stewardship program.

Mr Lacey has requested that Council lift the existing covenant.

It appears that the protection required by the original restrictive covenant is duplicated in the proposed covenant therefore Council's interests would be adequately protected.

#### Officer's Comment

The current amount recouped from users of standpipes is \$487, with the costs for standpipe water currently \$1,747. It is unlikely that the income will equal or exceed the costs as the standpipes are also used for fire fighting purposes. The other issue is the fact that there is unrestricted access to most of the standpipes throughout the shire.
