



### BUSHFIRE MITIGATION WORKS POPANYINNING, YORNANING & CUBALLING

The Shire of Cuballing has been awarded \$169,650 under the Department of Fire and Emergency Services Mitigation Activity Fund (MAF) Grants Program to support the fire management capacity within the Shire of Cuballing.

These funds are to be used for on-ground works to mitigate extreme, very high and high risks on land that is State Government controlled and managed by local government.

The Shire of Cuballing is about to commence these that include:

- reducing the extreme fuel loads in the reserve at the corner of Rose Street and Ridley Street Cuballing by mulching vegetation;
- establishing a fire access track in Yornaning townsite within the Horn and McCarthy Street road reserve in Yornaning;
- establishing and fencing a fire access track within the Edward Street road reserve in Popanyinning from the Hotham River, across Victoria Street to Daylesford Street;
- establishing a fire access track in Cuballing within the Boundary Road reserve from Springhill Road to Hart Street to Cuballing West Road in Cuballing; and
- mulching vegetation around wood road bridges throughout the Shire of Cuballing in order to reduce fuel loads beside these bridges

While the works may have some impact on properties directly adjoining the works, the Shire believe that the works will improve fire safety for in the Shire of Cuballing.



NRM is the management of natural resources such as land, water, soils, plants and animals. It brings together land use planning, water management, biodiversity conservation and sustainability of industries such as agriculture, mining, tourism, fisheries and forestry.

#### **Bushland Management Workshop**

A Bushland Management Workshop was held in Dryandra Woodland on the 26th of March, with the 29 attendees hearing from a range of speakers discussing threats to habitat and best management techniques.

Carla Tassone from DPIRD spoke about weeds of national significance and their control. Peter Denton spoke about how to best plan and execute a successful revegetation project and how to choose the best species to plant in our changing environment. Jim Miller (DPIRD) discussed pest animals, focusing on rabbits and feral pigs and how to best control them including prioritising baiting, then trapping and final shooting. Mitchell Davies (DBCA) talked about how to decide if and when you need to burn your bushland and how best do this to ensure you don't negatively impact on the vegetation and fauna with in it. Mitchell also took some of the attendees into Dryandra to show different areas of woodland at different stages post burn and the regeneration occurring in these areas.

Protecting on farm habitat is important for threatened species and we were able to hold this workshop through PHCC's Numbat Neighbourhood Project.



Parth, Fuenday. The passenger train, Albany to Perth, was to-day derailed to the extent of trucks between Cuballing and Yornaning. No one was injured. The passengers returned to Cuballing. The cause of the accident is alleged to be due to neglect to signal by a repair ing gang.


