
In the last few years, the Shire has been investing in its old buildings and making them fit for purpose. Rather than replacing old with new (and borrowing heavily), we are retaining and restoring our beautiful heritage buildings and making them better venues for our community activities. Council is currently working on a plan to improve the kitchen and toilet area in the Cuballing Agricultural Hall with the intention of upgrading the facilities and putting in a disabled toilet and shower. Since the acoustic ceilings, curtains and staging have been installed, as well as reverse cycle air conditioning, the hall has seen significantly more use. The CWA Hall too, now it has been upgraded, is being used several times a week and Council is enjoying using this space for its meetings.

I am really glad to see our beautiful old buildings becoming these vibrant community spaces and am looking forward to seeing the completion of the Popanyinning School as a community hub this year. Council is also looking at how it can improve the facilities at the recreation centre. The recreation hall gets more use than any other public building that we own, but the hall itself is pretty small and the kitchen very cramped so we are working on a longer term plan for that.

We are always looking for community input so please come along to our next meeting or contact one of the councillors to discuss your ideas.



Recent Ordinary Council Meetings held 18 December 2024 and 19 February 2025

Planning and Development Matter

• Application for Development Approval (Telecommunications Infrastructure) Lot 6997/DP125045 off Pennys Road, West Popanyinning – Council approved the Development Application in full, subject to the four planning conditions as listed in the report and other specific advice.

2023-24 Annual Report / Auditor's Report

In accordance with sections 5.53 and 5.54 of the *Local Government Act 1995,* Council resolved to accept the Annual Report and Independent Auditor's Report for the 2023-24 financial year.

Annual General Meeting of Electors

The Annual General Meeting of Electors was held on Wednesday 5th February 2025 at the Shire Chambers (old CWA Hall) in Cuballing, where the 2023-24 Annual Report was presented. No members of the public were in attendance.

Review of Delegations

Council endorsed and adopted the annual review of the Register of Delegations for 2024-25.

Amendment to 2024-25 Schedule of Fees and Charges

Council amended the weekly rental charge for the Austral Street Independent Living Units (Cuballing) to \$350 for the 2024-25 financial year; this had initially been set at \$375 per week when the Annual Budget was adopted in August 2024.

CEO KPIs for 2024-25

The Council unanimously accepted and adopted the Chief Executive Officer's Key Performance Indicators for the 2024-25 year.

Information Handling and Breach Policy

In line with the compliance requirements of the new *Privacy and Responsible Information Sharing Act 2024,* Council adopted the new Information Handling and Breach Policy in order to handle personal information privacy matters safely and responsibly.

Joint MOU – Library Services

A Memorandum of Understanding between the Shires of Cuballing and Narrogin to formalise the provision of library services was approved by Council; there had previously been no agreement in place.

River Bank Rehabilitation Update – Pumphreys Bridge

February's effort on the Hotham River at Koompkinning (Pumphreys Bridge) resulted in a 500m reach of the river being treated with various rehabilitation techniques.

Project partners Wilman (Dryandra) People Corporation provided a cultural induction before works began, due to the site being part of a Dreaming track, and holding a significant place in Noongar history and culture. The Wilman Corporation also provided two heritage monitors (in case archaeological items were unearthed) and two hard workers for much needed and appreciated on-ground support.

Rehabilitation techniques on the banks included:

- Gentle re-sloping, where there were steep slopes and no existing vegetation
- Pinning jute mat (biodegradable plant material to protect the bank, suppress weeds and provide a medium

for planting later in the year)

- Placing logs and woody debris for bank stabilisation and Rakali habitat (Australian Water Rat)
- Placing in-stream structures constructed with rock and/ or logs to slow down flows, restore river function, and improve habitat conditions.






