Bush Fire Meeting at Cuballing

The above meeting was held at Cuballing on August 19th., when Mr. S. H. Knight presided over Messrs. Buckley, Grout, Cavanagh, Grieve, Walsh, Hughes, J. Watts, Ferguson, Counsel, Mackinlay and the Secretary (Mr. A. Clark).

Apologies were received from Messrs. Kelly, F. Watts, Weatherhead and Dowling.

On explanation being given that last years motion requesting 33 and one-third per cent. reduction in Insurance rates for approved areas had not been followed up, it was requested that this matter be re-opened on motion Messrs. Ferguson and Hughes.—Carried.

There was some discussion on water supply at Popanyinning and it was finally decided to take no action as water was unsuitable for other purposes and there was a good supply at the bridge and the ford.

Election of Officers: As Mr. W. Cox had left the district and Mr. A. Quartermaine was leaving, it was decided that they be struck off the roll of Control Officers and that Mr. W. W. Dixon be elected instead, on motion Messrs. Mackinlay and Walsh.

Brigade Officers: Moved that all officers be re-elected except that P. Slee take place of W. Slee and that D. McCallum be added to Central East and D. J. Wiese to Central West, on motion of Messrs. Hughes and Ferguson.

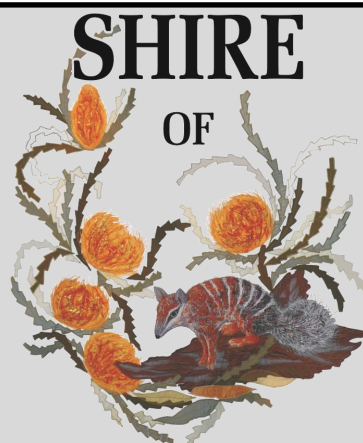
General Business: It was decided that 2 spare low down pumps be held in yard as they were of limited use now that there were so many power pumps in the District.

Community Burn: That where necessary, burn be held as usual, was moved Messrs. Hughes and Ferguson.

That Mr. Knight be appointed organiser and arrange publicity, was moved Messrs. Hughes and Counsel.

That Railway Dept. be asked to issue instructions that firebreaks be ploughed on new ground each year if possible, was moved Messrs. Counsel and Hughes.

The Secretary was instructed to try and avoid issue of burning permits to neighbouring farms for the same day.

Money Matters

As Council closes out the financial year, we are reviewing our performance and setting priorities for the 2026/27 budget. Much of Council's spending is already committed through grant requirements, legislation and essential services such as road maintenance, waste management, building maintenance, parks and gardens, and plant replacement, leaving limited funds for discretionary projects. Council has identified a list of preferred projects, guided by ratepayer requests and long-term strategic plans, which now need to be prioritised within the available budget. Plans and costings for other projects are also ready should additional Commonwealth or State Government funding become available during the year. The final budget will be set at the July Council meeting.

Excitement is building for Cuby GrooveFest in September, with more than 400 tickets already sold and allocated camping areas filling quickly. Additional camping locations are now being opened, but anyone with friends or family planning to attend should act soon. 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COUNCIL SHORTS

Renewal of Licensing Services Agreement with Department of Transport

As an agent of the Department of Transport, many services and payments related to driver and vehicle licensing can be handled by the Shire of Cuballing. The provision of licensing services at the Shire administration office is delivered as an essential service to our community. The cost of providing the service is partially offset by a commission fee received from the Department of Transport for undertaking these services on their behalf.

Council authorised the renewal of the agreement with the Department for a further five-year term ending 30 June 2031.

Local Planning Policy – Unhosted Short-Term Rental Accommodation

At the Ordinary Meeting held 14 November 2025 Council agreed to adopt an amendment to the Shire of Cuballing Local Planning Scheme No. 2, pursuant to section 75 of the Planning and Development Act 2005, to implement the State Government's planning reforms for short term rental accommodation. As part of implementing these reforms, a new local planning policy has been prepared to provide guidance and certainty to operators, customers and neighbours of short-term rental accommodation within the Shire. Council has resolved to prepare the new policy for the mandatory 21-day public advertising period, whereupon it will be formally adopted after comments/suggestions have been considered.

Appointment of Dual Fire Control Officers

At the request of the Shire of Wickiepin, Council appointed Mr Trevor Leeson, Mr Roger Butler and Mr Luke Lansdell as dual Fire Control Officers for the Shire of Cuballing.

Shire of Cuballing Events Information Guidelines Pack

Council considered and endorsed the proposed Events Information Guidelines Pack which is intended to provide an administrative guide for community groups, sporting clubs, businesses and organisers that seek to conduct significant public events within the Shire has been developed to provide a single point of reference for applicants and to improve the consistency of event approvals.

The Information Pack addresses event applications, insurance, risk management, food vending, liquor licensing, emergency services, temporary structures, crowd control, toilets, water, electricity, rubbish, noise, camping, traffic management and signage. Of specific note, the noise management provisions contained in the document are intended to balance successful community events with the protection of residential amenity.

2026 WALGA AGM and Convention

Council nominated Deputy Shire President Councillor Robert Harris and Councillor Scott Ballantyne as the voting delegates for the 2026 WA Local Government Association Annual General Meeting and Convention to be held on 16th to 18th September in Perth.

Proposed Bushfire Brigade Restructure and Training Framework

Council reviewed and endorsed a proposal to commence the restructure the Shire of Cuballing Bushfire Service into two separate brigades, being Cuballing and Popanyinning, and the adoption of formal training standards for our brigade volunteer members and FCOs. The proposed structure aligns with contemporary emergency management principles by establishing clear brigade leadership, defined response areas, improved accountability and streamlined mobilisation arrangements whilst maintaining operational flexibility during larger emergency or hazard incidents.

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PUBLIC NOTICE – Avian Influenza (Bird Flu) Awareness – Western Australia

Authorities in Western Australia are reminding the community to stay alert and follow biosecurity guidance following monitoring and detections of avian influenza (bird flu) in wildlife and poultry in parts of Australia.

Avian influenza is a viral disease that can spread among birds and, in rare cases, to humans through close or unprotected contact with infected birds.

The situation is being monitored by the Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development (Western Australia) in coordination with animal and public health authorities.

What the community needs to do:

1. Do not touch sick or dead birds

- Avoid handling wild birds or poultry showing signs of illness or found dead.

Keep children and pets away from them.

2. Report sightings

Report sick or dead birds or unusual poultry deaths to local biosecurity or wildlife authorities immediately. (Sick birds typically have difficulty walking and holding their head up and may have discharge from the nose or eyes)

3. Practice good hygiene

- Wash hands thoroughly after any outdoor activity, especially near parks, farms, wetlands, or bird habitats.

Do not bring contaminated footwear or equipment into homes or poultry areas.

4. Protect backyard poultry

- Keep chickens and other birds in secure enclosures to reduce contact with wild birds.

Ensure food and water sources are covered and not accessible to wildlife.

5. Food safety reminder

- Properly cooked poultry and eggs remain safe to eat.

Always follow standard food handling and cooking hygiene.

Stay informed through official updates and follow all biosecurity directions to help protect wildlife, pets, and the community.

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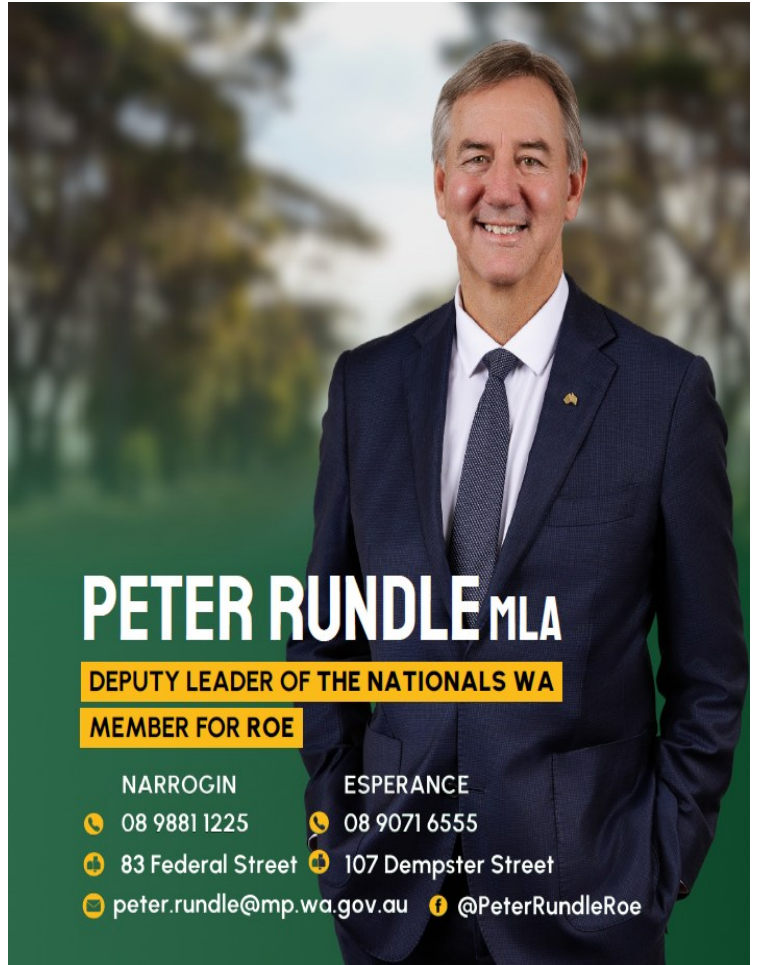
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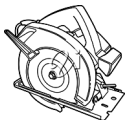
